15 Hours Funding

All three and four year olds in England are entitled to a free early learning place via Government funding. This allows you to claim up to 15 hours per week for free at Cundall Manor Nursery. Parents can then use additional hours, which are billed at an hourly rate. Early Years funding is available the term after your child has their third birthday and continues until the term after your child has their fifth birthday (for example a child who turns 3 on the 2nd February, will receive funding from the Summer Term until the end of the Lent Term when they turn 5).

Claiming the funding is simple; when you child becomes eligible, we will contact you and ask you to fill out a Parental Declaration which confirms your child's details and the sessions you wish to claim funding for. Cundall Manor then claim the funding on your behalf and your Nursery Invoice will reflect this, and any additional sessions you may do.

30 Hours Funding

Some children may also be eligible for additional funding. This is arranged and applied for direct by the Government, please find details at https://www.gov.uk/30-hours-free-childcare

To give you an idea on sessions and additional costs, please see the table below, however, the exact fee will depend on the combination of AM/PM/Full day sessions. Please note, hours taken in After School Clubs (including after school care) cannot be part of your 15 hour allocation.
